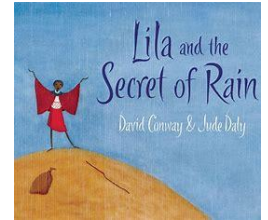


Home Learning Ideas

In Science this half term, we will be continuing to learn about living things and habitats. We will learn about how different living things depend on each other within a habitat and look at examples of food chains.

In Geography, we will be looking at maps of the world. We will learn about the 7 continents and 5 oceans.

In Art this half term, we will be developing our drawing and painting skills and exploring the artwork created by Paul Klee.

Home Learning is encouraged so that your child can share with you some of the knowledge and skills learnt in school as well as allow them to learn more and follow their own areas of interest. It can also help your child to become more involved in the learning and become more independent with their thinking. If you would like some ideas please use the list below, but these are merely suggestions, and it would be great to see what the children think of themselves.

We can't wait to see what the children produce this half term...

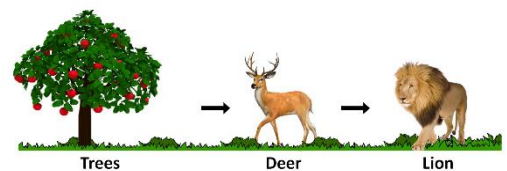
Home Learning Ideas

- Make a self-portrait in the style of Paul Klee. Start with a circle, draw lines across it, add the eyes and then fill in the sections with block colours.



- Explore different ways of using a paintbrush to make marks e.g. splashing, splattering, scratching, dotting.

- Investigate the habitats near where you live. Which living things can you see? Can you create a food chain using these living things?



- Create a booklet or write a fact-file about the 7 continents and 5 oceans.
- Design posters that encourage people to keep healthy. Think about all the different things we need to stay healthy and happy.
- Make a WANTED poster for a character in a traditional tale e.g. the wolf in Little Red Riding Hood or the giant/Jack in Jack and the Beanstalk.
