You could design a superhero costume for a new superhero you have thought of.

Inspired by Supertato, you could Create your own 'super veggie' and have fun writing speech bubbles for your vegetable.

How could you be your own superhero at home? Could you do something to help the environment, such as a bug hotel or hedgehog house?

You could design and make a superheroes vehicle that they use out of junk modelling materials. What decorations could you add once it's done?

Design you own super healthy meal for a superhero. You and your adult could have a go at making it together.



Can you write simple sentences? You could describe anything you make or see at home. Have a go at making a superhero and describe it (My superhero is called... They can fly and are really strong) or write a story about the adventure it went on.

Can you write the numbers 1-20? Practice counting beyond 20, how far can you go?

Can you race your adult to say all our number bonds to 5 and 10! Who could remember them all quicker?

Play a game to remember our odd and even numbers, what do you notice about them? You could also practise addition and subtraction number sentences to help you.
